

1. What are the specific spiritual needs you see for the women in the fellowship and how will you provide support and resources to address them?

I think the women in the fellowship are seeking connection with not only God, but also with one another. Since university life is so fast-paced and hectic, it can be easy to forget to slow down and spend quality time with God. Our relationship with God can begin to feel distant and we become unsure of how to fix it. In my experience, rekindling the passion for God requires going all in and prioritizing Him. I hope to encourage the women of ACF to regularly attend ACF events and maintain spiritual disciplines, in order to be united with God. To make the opportunity to encourage the women, I hope that women's cell will bring all the women together to learn and meditate on what God wants from us, as women of God. Additionally, I found that women in ACF lack inter-year connections with other women. Inter-year connections are very important, especially in our life stage; the wisdom and guidance of older women that have lived our current problems can make a huge difference in our lives. Hopefully, women's cells will jumpstart inter-year mingling and closeness that can be carried on throughout the school year.

2. How will you pour into your KGLs specifically?

I think being a KGL (especially a solo KGL) is a lot of work and can be quite a burden for one person to carry. From the start, it's easy to feel unprepared and inadequate to lead fellow sisters in Christ. Throughout the school year, it can be quite the time commitment to lead a KOIN every week, attend ACF events, and attend monthly pre-studies. Finally, it's common to feel discouraged when KOIN attendance is down. I would prioritize regularly asking for their prayer requests and praying with them, as I believe that the power of prayer and faith can truly make a huge difference. From the start, I'd like to ensure that the KGLs are able to get to familiar with one another and hopefully, they'll be able to rely on one another throughout the year and spread positivity to those who are having a harder time. I think maintaining the KGL one-on-one chats throughout the year will be important to reach that goal. In order to have more fresh KGLs in the following year, I hope to partner potential future KGLs with KGLs who can be intentional in showing them the ropes, preparing them to KGL in the next year. Ultimately, I intend to care for them and show them the love that I've received from God and others in ACF, so that they know I'm always ready to support and pray for them.
