

How will you work with other religious organizations and student groups on campus to promote interfaith understanding and cooperation?

I have always enjoyed exploring different religion; however, I think due to the different style of worship, it can often become intimidating. It will make people feel more comfortable if events are in a smaller scale. By inviting them to join our typical Friday nights, it will allow them to ask questions about our faith and experience the ACF community.

How will you encourage members to be involved in campus evangelism?

I also want to create an accountability system where people who are committed to campus evangelism can keep track of their evangelism progress. It is difficult to focus on community outside of a university setting. The best way to approach a community outside of university will be serving them. We can dedicate a weekend to do bottle sorting or soup kitchen to raise fund and care for the London community. We might also be able to cooperate with WLA since they have more resources to do street evangelism in London.
