The vision you have for your ministry, the vision you have for the fellowship and your calling or heart for this particular ministry.

Living by the verse in Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the Gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes," has been my guiding principle. As the VP External, my priority is to instill confidence in Jesus among ACF members and bring people closer to God both inside and outside of ACF.

To achieve these goals, I propose organizing evangelism workshops twice a year. These workshops will impart fundamental Gospel truths and equip participants with effective ways to share them. Additionally, I aim to establish an accountability system for individuals committed to campus evangelism, ensuring we keep track of our progress. I believe that evangelism should be a natural part of our lifestyle, and this system will serve as a reminder to consistently live out our faith.

In addition to the evangelism workshops and the campus evangelism accountability group, I highly recommend that worship teams perform at talent shows as a means of sharing the good news through musical worship. This approach has proven to be highly effective in the past, as it has inspired university students to openly declare their faith and has boosted the confidence of ACF members.

Serving as VP External allows me to align my love for Jesus and ACF. Evangelism is a crucial aspect of this role and I believe that sharing the Gospel is not just something we do once in a while, but a way of life. I went on a mission trip before coming to Western, and it instilled in me the confidence to fearlessly share the Gospel with others. I think the short-term nervousness during evangelism pales in comparison to the eternal impact of fostering the Kingdom of God in someone's life.
