What are the specific spiritual needs you see for the men in the fellowship and how will you provide support and resources to address them?

In general, I feel like having a KOIN group that is able to share their vulnerable moments is a good KOIN group, because I feel that in a KOIN group, sharing struggles and vulnerable moments make for connections and accountability that lasts. Rather than the many shallow friendships many men experience. I will do this by having a group with a variety of members and years. I find that with the variety of years, so that everyone gets to share a wider variety of experiences. In addition, when signing up for KOIN groups, I would like to get members to put their personality type if they want to so designating and catering different groups would be easier for KGLs and myself. I also wanna continue something like the KOIN tourney established by Joshua Rainer Chua as I find it is a fun ACF wide activity to spread love and fellowship with one another.

How will you pour into your KGLs specifically?

I will encourage them and keep them accountable through having meetups with the KGLs, either 1 on 1s or as a group. I will also be praying for them in my prayers and for the rest of the fellowship as well. I think also sharing and being intimate with them can encourage them to do the same with their groups.
